> As per the Government Order first read above, the State Government Employees are entitled to avail three 'Restricted Holidays' in a year, on the festivals / occasions from the 'Restricted Holidays' enlisted in the Annexure to the Government Order at their option and irrespective of the religion to which the festival pertains. Permission to avail oneself of these holidays should be applied, in writing, in advance and will normally be granted by the superior officer, competent to grant casual leave, except that the presence of an employee is considered necessary, in exigencies of Government work.

- 2. In the Government Order second read above, 'Bhagawan Vaigundaswami Birthday' was included in the list of Restricted Holidays, as Serial Number 33.
- 3. Request had been made to the Government that 'Shabe Bharath' in respect of Muslims and 'All souls Day' in respect of Christians, which are the occasions to remember departed souls in the family and to do their rites and rituals which had already been included in the list of restricted holidays in Serial Numbers 15 and 21 respectively and that similar such occasions in respect of Hindus, i.e. Mahalaya Amavasai shall be included in the list of 'Restricted Holidays'.
- 4. The Government after careful consideration of the above request direct that the occasion 'MAHALAYA AMAVASAI' shall be included as one of the restricted holidays at Serial Number 34.
 - 5. The list of restricted holidays is annexed to this order.
